Please be aware that as the trip will be returning after the end of the school day, you will need to make alternative arrangements with regards to your child getting home.

Students are not required to wear their School Uniform for this event but will need to bring a pen to complete the workbook provided. A spare is advised, as there will not be resources available on the day. A calculator is also recommended.

Students are also asked to bring a snack for the comfort break as they will not be allowed to leave the Venue. For lunch, students will be allowed 45mins to explore Westfields Shopping Centre. During this time, they can buy food to eat, however they can bring their own lunch with them if they prefer and stay at the Venue with staff members.
