Behaviour Hubs Programme

The Buckingham School is taking part in the Behaviour Hubs programme; a Department for Education-funded programme to improve behaviour in schools. We have been paired with an exemplary lead school who will guide us through a year of support, in which we will develop new behaviour cultures to make sure that all students can learn in a calm, safe and supportive environment.
