While the academic performance of our students remains impressive, I would like to draw your attention to a matter of concern relating to the adherence of uniform standards. It has come to my notice that there has been a slip in the uniform compliance among some students in recent days. Your support in reinforcing the importance of adhering to our uniform expectations would be greatly appreciated.

As per our School policy, students are not permitted to wear hoodies while on the premises. However, they are allowed to wear the School jumper and coat during Mock Exams in the Exam Hall. It is imperative that students wear school shoes with black socks, black school trousers and refrain from having any facial piercings. Failure to comply with the Uniform Policy will result in the issuance of a B3 - 'failing to comply'.
